Our mission is to bring to the community a love and respect for the art of ballet while providing aspiring dancers the opportunity to hone their craft. In past years, we have brought to the stage of the Brewster Performing Arts Center several well-known classics --- *The Sleeping Beauty*, *Cinderella*, *Peter and the Wolf*, and *Rodeo* --- along with works of original choreography, some to live music. We have been fortunate to collaborate with professional musicians and the Westchester/Putnam Youth Symphony. Prelude Ballet Ensemble has been honored in 2008, 2009 and now, in 2010, to receive grants through the Putnam Arts Council from the New York State Council on the Arts Decentralization Program. This is a significant endorsement of our efforts to promote ballet in the lower Hudson Valley and something we treasure.
